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## **INCOME TAX FILING STATUS**

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## **IDENTITY AND STATEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL PURPOSE**

If the notary statement appears on a separate page than the Statement of Educational Purpose, there must be a clear indication that the Statement of Educational Purpose was the document notarized. <u>This section must be</u> completed in the presence of a Public Notary.
